Either fill out this paper form and mail it in with a check for the \$50 deposit, or go to **CampBarakel.org** and register online using a credit card. No phone registrations.

We will send a confirmation and additional information (including a link to an online health form) to the email address you provide. If you do not have an email address, we will send you this information by U. S. mail.

If you do not have an email address, we will send you a health form and travel plan by U.S. mail.

Registrations are taken individually, not by group. All housing arrangements and assignments are made after the campers arrive. If your child wants to be housed with one or two friends, they simply stand together when cabin groups ("tribes") are formed.

Fees

The cost for each of the two High School weeks is \$270, and all the other weeks cost \$245. A deposit of \$50 must accompany the registration form. The balance is due one week prior to arrival. If you are unable to attend your week of camp, the registration deposit is refundable if we are notified no less than two weeks prior to the Tuesday your week begins.

Transportation....

To help you with transportation time and costs, Barakel provides its own fleet of buses (and a luggage truck). Bus stops are located in Marshall, Lansing, Flint and Bay City. This service is provided at no additional charge! Each bus is Department of Transportation inspected (our license is U.S. D.O.T. 1668581). It is driven by a state-licensed commercial driver, and two additional attendants ride along to give assistance to campers.
